Are COVID-19 vaccines safe?

Yes, approximately 13 billion people have received the COVID-19 vaccine and only .000005% of the population have had severe reactions. That means you are 200X more likely to be struck by lightning than have a severe reaction to the vaccine.

How can such a new vaccine be safe for people?

The MRNA technology used to make the vaccines has been around since the mid-198Os. So, it is not new at all. It was just the first time they used it to make vaccines.

Can I get sick from the vaccine itself?

No, there is **no virus in the vaccine** so it can't give you COVID-19. Any tiredness, fatigue, or mild fever you feel is just your body making antibodies to protect you from COVID-19.

Is the vaccine safe if I have a chronic disease?

Absolutely. Having conditions like high blood pressure, diabetes, or asthma increases your chances of getting seriously ill from COVID-19. So, its particularly important for you to get a vaccine this year.

Are COVID-19 vaccines safe for children?

Yes, the vaccines are very safe for kids. Just like adults, there have been very few cases of severe reactions.

Why get more COVID-19 shots if I've already had some?

Two reasons to get the COVID-19 vaccine this year: Last year's may not work as well now, and this one is made to fight the **current virus**.

How much will it cost to get the vaccines?

Zero. If you have insurance, the vaccine is **covered by insurance**. If you don't have insurance, the federal **government will cover the cost**.





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
